A selection of new luxury hotels have hit the Jamaican shores over the last few months but LTI is most excited about Trident Castle and Trident Hotel, which have recently opened in Port Antonio. Geejam Collection owns both hotels.

**Trident Castle's** impressive seven-acre oceanfront estate was originally built for the eccentric Earl Levy, who entertained a host of Hollywood celebrities there over the years. Today, it maintains a faded charm and lots of original character – there are eight bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms, four-poster beds, 500 thread count sheets and ocean views. The main hall has an epic 47-foot ceiling and doubles up as one of Jamaica's most acoustically gifted music halls, while the dining room is the country's largest formal eating space.

**Trident Hotel's** modern minimalist exterior hosts 13 spacious villas and studios equipped for the sophisticated traveller and is the epitome of Caribbean cool. Amenities include outdoor soaking tubs, wet bars, steam rooms, and sleek interiors complete with WiFi and flat screen Apple TVs.
